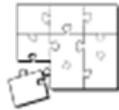
RESCUE REPORT

Essential Rules for Restraint*

Certain universal rules apply to restraining your dog when he's in the car:

- Never restrain him using a neck collar.
- Always restrain him in a backseat away from airbags.
- Restrain his movement as much as you can. The more securely contained he is—just like us—the less likely he'll be injured in an accident.
- Never leave your dog unattended in the car—restrained or not. You put him at risk for life-threatening heatstroke, even on what seems a relatively cool day.
